BEDLINGTON AND DISTRICT MOTOR CLUB

The purpose of the club is to organise off road motorcycle events, known as trials. The club is affiliated to the Auto Cycle Union who govern motorcycle sport in England and Wales, the Auto Cycle Union was originally formed in 1904. Bedlington Motor Club was formed in 1950 by Alan Calvert and Jimmy Smith. The club currently has 33 members, in the early days the club is known to have had a working relationship with the Hunters of Puncherton.

People often consider all forms of off road motorcycle sport to be speed related. However in a typical motorcycle trial there are no points to be gained for speed or being finished first. A trial is a test of the riders ability to pilot his or her machine over obstacles set by the organiser. Penalties are awarded for using your feet to assist balance and the lowest number of penalties is the winner of the event.

All of the events organised by the club take place in Northumberland with venues near Rothbury, Elsdon and Alwinton. The club run single and two day events and in total run 6 events each year. Club events are run in cooperation with the National Park, the Police the Forestry Commission and other land owners. The two day events are the highlights of the clubs year attracting not only riders from the North East but also from all corners of the United Kingdom.

On Easter weekend the club run an event near Rothbury specifically for restored and classic off road machines. Early trials machines were little more than adapted road bikes but people still like to ride such machines which date back to the 1960's. During the late 1960's the British motorcycle industry ceased to make large volumes of bikes and trials bikes have largely been of European manufacture since. At the clubs event for older bikes you can see bikes made in Spain, Italy and Japan as well as the older British machines being ridden over a suitable course.

In June the club now run the Alwinton Two Day for modern machines. This event was first run in 2011 although parts of the course have been used for separate events since the 1970s, if not earlier. The club are grateful for the cooperation of the Forestry Commission and local landowners who allow the event to take place. Last year's event attracted riders from North Yorkshire, the South East, Lancashire and Scotland. The event is quickly getting a reputation as a must do trial with the added bonus of a social gathering on the Saturday evening.

It is our intention for the local area to benefit from the event by providing accommodation and food to the riders. The club are grateful to the management of Clennel Hall and The Rose and Thistle who have worked with the club to get the event established. The event now starts and finishes each day at Clennel Hall which is a great location. Hopefully our event will continue to grow.
