Stop Northumberland County Council's plans to axe free travel for post-16 students

Northumberland County Council's administration is planning to scrap free travel for post-16 students travelling to and from school or college - replacing it with a £450 annual charge. The plans have been criticised across the county, warning that it would have a huge damaging effect on the prospect of the county's young people, particularly in rural and remote areas. The plans are also looking at the viability of continuing to provide Post-16 out-of-county travel to establishments like Newcastle or Gateshead College.

Two mums from Elsdon have come up with a solution to the problem of how to return to work in rural Northumberland. Taking their plans to start a sewing business, 'Dizzy Birds', one step further with the help of the National Park, they have decided to take the initiative and create 'The Spiral Project'. The idea of the project is to create a spiral patchwork hanging $5m^2$ which will depict what 'life' means to as wide a cross-section of people/communities in the UK. The sessions are free, anyone can take part, no sewing experience or skill is required. At each venue they will deliver a 1 day session working in conjunction with a local artist. The hanging will be unique, in that people will be encouraged to represent their own ideas in their own way or to join in and work as a group on a collective piece. The tour will link National Parks in rural locations and Art's Council areas in urban locations. Each event is free and will run from the morning through to the evening, mid-week and at weekends, in an attempt to make it accessible to everyone. Throughout the day there will be many opportunities for discussion and for people to share their ideas, stories and experiences.

Pilot Sessions

Prior to the launch, two pilot sessions are scheduled; the first at Tarset Village Hall, **1st March 2014** from 10am to 3.30pm. Feel free to attend for the whole or part of the day. Although all events including the pilots are FREE, booking is strongly recommended, particularly if you are travelling, although some spaces may be available on the day. All children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by an adult.
