#### **Digital Coquetdale**

The Upper Coquet Mobile and Broadband Campaign has rebranded as Digital Coquetdale www.digitalcoquetdale.org or search for Digital Coquetdale on Facebook.

Some of us attended a meeting of Northumberland County Council's North Area Committee, where there was a presentation by Arch Digital (NCC team in charge of superfast broadband) and BT. We won't know for certain where the BT roll-out will go until the end of 2015. We're having a meeting with BT this month, hoping to get more precise details. This just makes it harder to get funding for the wireless broadband scheme Arch Digital is planning as Phase 2, but they still hope it will get the go-ahead. We also took the opportunity to ask the council to help us get a mobile mast up here.

Since the meeting, Arch Digital have been in touch to say that the next round of government broadband funding is likely to be spent based on the level of demand, rather than just the number of properties covered, so please all sign up again at www.inorthumberland.org.uk/we-need-your-help/.

We have written letters to the great and good and Matt Ridley raised a question about Coquetdale in the House of Lords – the minister said he would look into it – the transcript from Hansard says:

#### Viscount Ridley (Con):

My Lords, I take us from one end of the country to the other. While I warmly welcome the rollout of superfast broadband throughout the country, what words of comfort does my noble friend have for the inhabitants of Upper Coquetdale, running up to the Scottish border in Northumberland, particularly in the villages of Alnham, Alwinton, Hepple, Holystone, Netherton and Sharpeton, who have not only no broadband but no mobile coverage? They are in a "not spot" and there are no plans for them to get out of it yet.

We're writing a white paper explaining our problem and suggesting solutions to present to the politicians, so please fill in the survey that was in the April newsletter and sign the petition on the website or in the pubs and post offices. We're hoping to put some pressure on the Department of Culture, Media and Sport to make sure we're included in the subsidised mobile roll-out and to get the NCC and the National Park and Alan Beith to back us up.

We're also looking into the possibility of community wireless broadband – we're determined to crack this one way or another. It may take a while, but as more and more things are done online and the rest of the world moves to gigabit broadband we can't afford to be left out.
